



ONTARIO POLICE BADGE RIDE 2010 PARTICIPANT GUIDE

IMPORTANT: Please Ensure You HAVE A FULL TANK of FUEL!!!!
(TOTAL RIDE LENGTH IS approximately 180 Kilometers)

** Top up is available at Shell - located @ Innisfil Beach Rd just east of HWY 400.

** YOU MUST HAVE WITH YOU: valid driver's licence, vehicle registration & insurance.

While there are a few things to remember during the ride, our foremost priority is *SAFETY*.

Be aware of other riders and traffic at all times. Obey all rules of the road and traffic laws and follow direction(s) given you by police on the ride. Follow crew directions at all parking areas.

RIDE in staggered formation with adequate space between bikes. Stay in formation and keep position to avoid outside traffic entering ride, this promotes a safe riding atmosphere for all.

Keep you speed as even as you can for the duration of the ride, there is lots of great scenery and no hurry or rush. Moderating any increase or decrease in speed will help the ride move more smoothly and keep gaps to a minimum. Depending on your location within the ride you may experience a bit of a slinky effect at times, should this occur, adjust you speed and braking smoothly to reduce the effect.

BREAK DOWNS – Should you experience a mechanical break down, carefully signal you intention and move safely to the shoulder of the roadway and activate your emergency flashers. Remain with your bike at a safe distance from the roadway and wait. **THE CHASE VEHICLE WILL ASSIST YOU.** (Note: Auto Club membership covering a motorcycle shall be utilized in every situation for fuel, boosts and/or towing. The Badge Ride Chase Vehicle is **ONLY** able to provide emergency assistance and removal under strict guidelines and may only bring any motorcycle to Lion's Gate Banquet Hall.

PERSONAL COMFORT: The ride does not stop, so please dress appropriate to the weather conditions before departure. If you have to stop/leave the ride, you will not be permitted to rejoin ride while it is in motion). Please utilize restroom facilities at OLG Slots prior to ride departure.

SHOULD YOU REQUIRE FUEL OR REST ROOM FACILITIES DURING THE RIDE, please make your intention to leave the ride known to those riders in your immediate area and when safe to do so, signal and move to the right side of the lane to slow down and exit the ride. **WASHROOM FACILITIES ARE AVAILABLE AT OUR SCHEDULED STOP.**

There are several gas stations along the route, but a full tank on departure is best and should easily get your through the entire ride, start to finish. In the event you do leave the ride, please refer to the following maps in order that you may rejoin the ride at the Blue Mountain rest stop or catch up with the ride at the Lion's Gate Banquet Hall in Barrie.

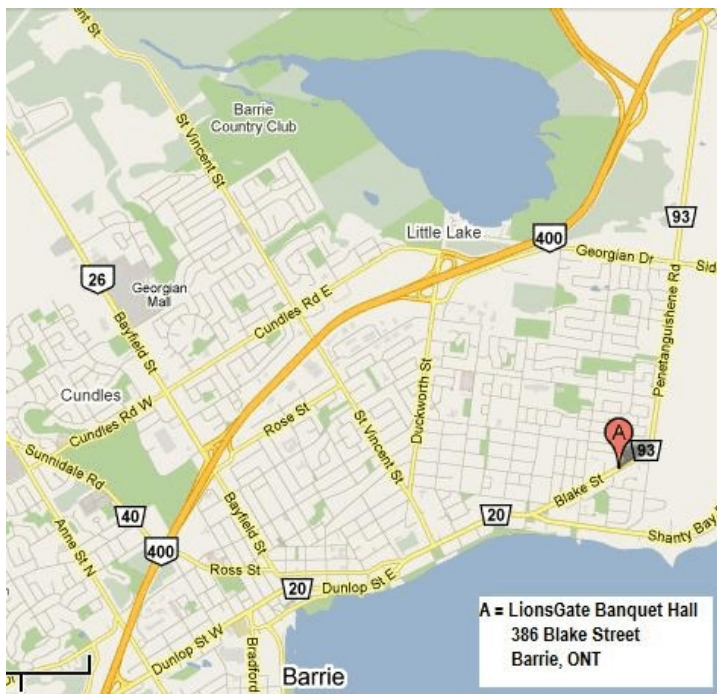
ROUTE: Badge Ride will head from OLG Slots at Georgian Downs towards Creemore area & Blue Mountain where it will stop for rest/stretch. After break ride will head back to Barrie arriving at Lion's Gate Banquet Hall, 386 Blake Street, Barrie, Ontario for dinner and relaxation.

POST RIDE HWY 400 Access: To return to Hwy 400, take Blake St north, left from parking lot, to Hwy 11 or take Blake St south, right from parking lot, & follow to Hwy 400 (at Dunlop Exchange).
